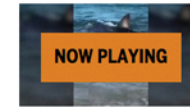

PHOTO EXHIBIT ON MARTHA'S VINEYARD

Those longing for a connection to the natural world during a time of global crisis may want to check out the photographs of Libby Ellis on display at The Carnegie Museum in Edgartown on Martha's Vineyard (through Nov. 7). In the exhibit, "Joyful Participation in a World of Sorrows," the large-scale, black-and-white photographs' contemplative portraits of flowers, torn leaves, tangled stems, rumpled petals, and hidden insects aim to reveal "joyful beauty during sorrowful times." Ellis's award-winning work has previously been included in exhibitions at the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the Eric Carle Museum, and other galleries around the United States.
